Scripture Meditation of the Week

Ephesians 2:10

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Among our greatest human passions is to have significance, and to know what is coming next in our lives. When we finally recognize that our significance is found in our identify in Christ, and not our identity in the world we are then freed from the demands of the world and can serve it better. God so loved the world that He gave His only Son to serve it through His death and resurrection for the forgiveness of our sins, coming not to be served but to serve. We, being Christ followers, are called to do the same. The world didn't recognize it then, and won't now, but that is when we are the most significant to them.

When we recognize that our significance is in Christ, we can see what God means when He calls us His 'workmanship'. We are His masterpiece, created for His good pleasure; to participate in all He has laid out for us. Sadly, we fall so very short of that, and never begin to realize all God has in store. Our desire for pleasure, our arrogance, lead us to believe that we are better positioned to call the shots. The nation of Israel did that when they refused to enter the Promised Land, held back by fear. And an entire generation wandered about, dying off, with nothing to show for their lives
